## **NORTHERN CALIFORNIA HEALTH CARE SYSTEM OPENS MEDICAL APPOINTMENTS FOR VETERANS IN THE YUBA CITY AREA**

**SACRAMENTO** – Local veterans will not have to travel as far with Veteran services now available in Yuba City. The Northern California Health Care System has partnered with the Feather River Tribal Health to provide health care to our Veterans closer to home.

Veterans in the Yuba City/Marysville area will be able to receive their primary care at the **Feather River Tribal Health located at 1231 Plumas Street, Yuba City**. For Veterans wanting to schedule an appointment call **530-751-8457, Monday through Friday 8 a.m. to noon and 1 p.m. to 5 p.m.** The clinic will be available to see Veterans on Tuesdays and Thursdays and as more Veterans come in to be seen the appointment availability will grow as well. The first Veteran will be seen at the Feather River Tribal Health Clinic Sept. 22.

This is a joint venture between the Indian Health Service Feather River Tribal Health, which is a Native American healthcare clinic, and the Department of Veterans Affairs Northern California Health Care System.

“This joint venture sets the foundation for the soon-to-be-established Yuba City/Marysville Community Based Outpatient Clinic (CBOC). Work has already started on the implementation and the CBOC is expected to open within six months,” said Brian J. O’Neill, MD, director. "Northern California Health Care System covers 40,000 square miles and 17 counties and our goal is to provide world-class health care and serve our Veterans in Northern California closer to their home."
